Responsive Design


- Developing websites to create an optimal viewing experience, regardless of device.
- Improvements in the ability to view, read, navigate with minimal scrolling, panning or pinching
- Mobile browsing now outpaces desktop
- Input devices vary mouse, touchscreen
- It's like we are building a house on land that is constantly changing shape, form, dimension


- Ethan Marcotte first articulated challenges in AListApart

- Now all websites need to be developed with responsive characteristics








Pros and Cons

- Pros
 - Single website/single url
 - Easy SEO
 - Easy marketing
 - Low cost
- Cons
- Single website may not take advantage of the platform/may not optimize user experience
- Outdated browsers may not display properly



Mobile Web App

- Pros
 - Better user experience
 - Faster
 - Might cost less than making an app
 - Search/accessibility
- Cons
 - Multiple URLs
 - Maintenance
 - Many different devices
- Best for sites you want available in browser (say because you want to have links to them), but need specific functionality ex. Meetup.com



Native Mobile App

Native Mobile App

- Pros
 - Better user experience
 - Load fast, content may be accessible offline
 - Feature rich
 - Visibility on device
- Cons
 - Must develop for each OS
 - Not flexible for updates
 - Expensive/complicated development
 - Can't link to it
 - Marketing and SEO different strategies for native app
- Best for games and apps that require specific functionality/apps that have a very specific/defined purpose – Shazam, Foursquare



Fluid Layout

Media Queries

- Special rules for presentation at a certain size. Can use multiple media queries to design for a range of styles.
- Most frequently change things like width, height, margin and float, but can change anything like padding, backgrounds and whether something should display or not.
